Centre of Excellence for Prescribed Burning

with Greg Esnouf

Through 2011-17 the National Burning Project (NBP) brought together inter-related aspects of prescribed burning across Australasia to design guiding frameworks and principles for a more holistic and consistent approach to prescribed burning. The intention of these two professional development sessions is to facilitate greater understanding and uptake of the national guidelines, frameworks, principles and best practice guidelines within land and fire management organisations.

Session One – Centre of Excellence for Prescribed Burning

1.30 – 2.30 pm (*Limited to approx. 60 participants, this session is a pre-requisite for Session Two*)

This session includes a presentation on the newly formed Centre of Excellence for Prescribed Burning and the developed products available to assist with prescribed burning programs.

Session Two – Developing a Burn Plan

3.00 – 4.00 pm (*Limited to 30 participants, participants must have attended Session One*)

This workshop will feature group work based on applying the products to a real-life prescribed burning scenario for operational planning (developing a burn plan) and burn implementation. Participants will learn how to utilise NBP products such as:

- National position on prescribed burning
- Risk management frameworks for fuel mitigation, smoke, ecological and operational safety risks
- The objectives setting tool, performance measures and objectives and monitoring framework
- National best practice principles/guidelines
- Step by step guide on prescribed burning
- The training resource kits for prescribed burning
